## From the Administration menu, choose Restore

To restore backed up files to this computer, you must first Request Files, which will guide you through the download and restoration process. You will need the Encryption Key you created when installing this software.

You will have the opportunity to select files and folders to be restored, and to reconfirm your selection before restoring them to disk. You may restore any or all files to an alternate destination.

**Request Files** **The starting point for Restoring one or more files. Connects to the Backup Server for download. This option will also retrieve Archive sets created with WireBack.**

**Multiple Sets** If restore sets have already been downloaded using 'Request Files', select files to restore

**Single Set** If a single restore set has been downloaded using 'Request Files', select files to restore

**Manage** Move or delete Restore Sets on this computer

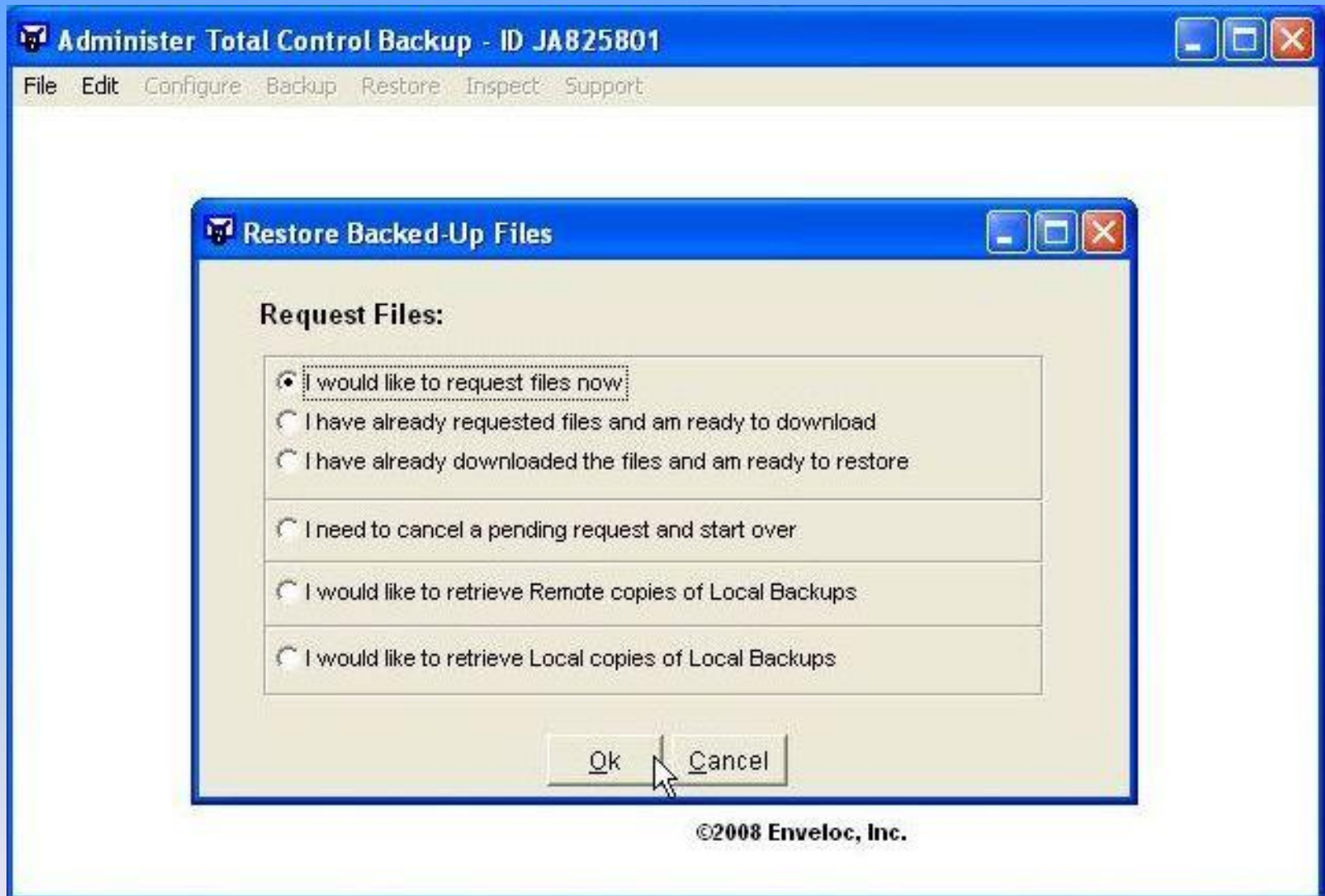
**Remove** If your Restoration replaced obsolete files that are not needed, select them for removal

A button labeled "<-Back" is located at the bottom right of the window.

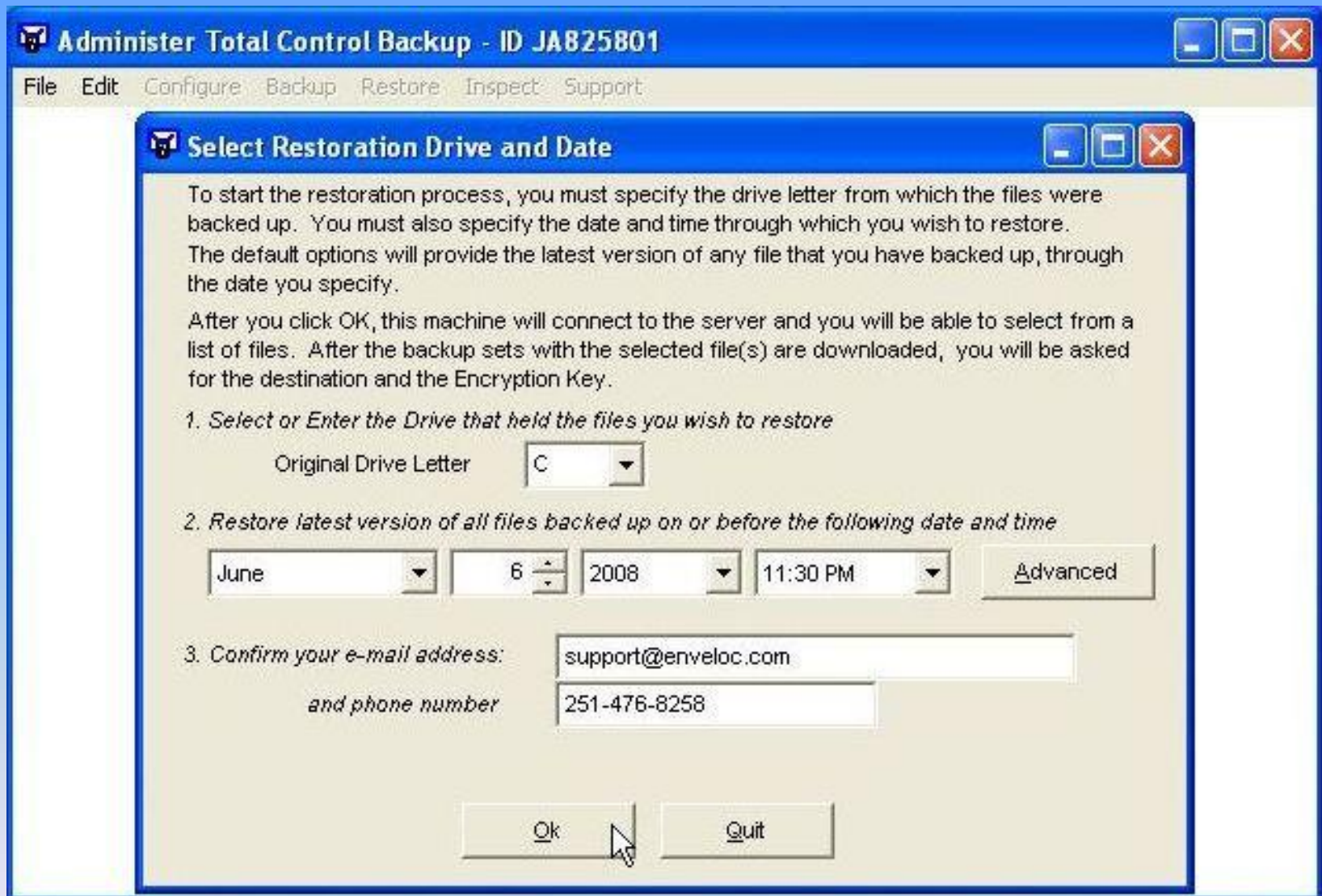
Then click Request Files to begin



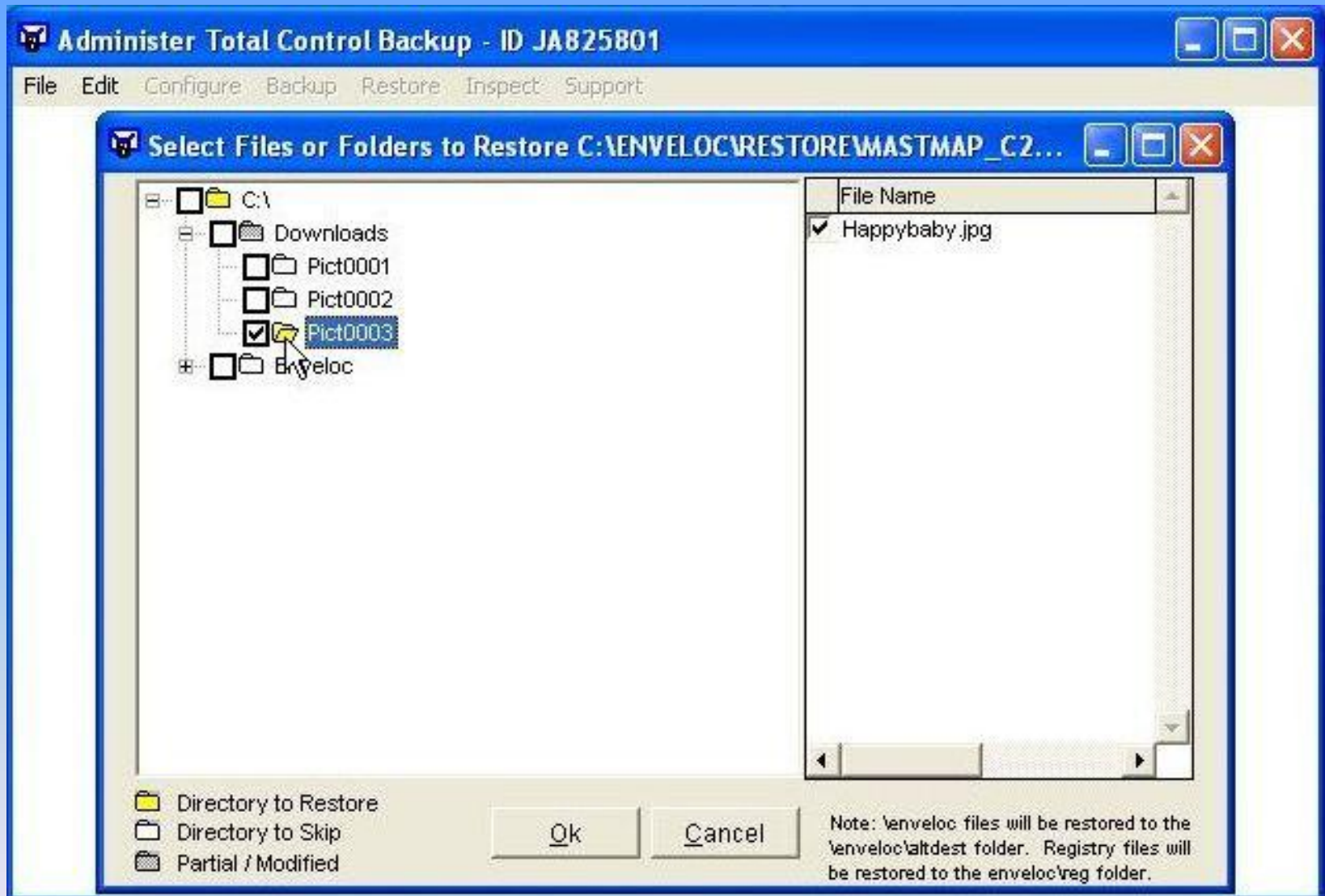
**Click Yes unless you are resuming a previous restoration**



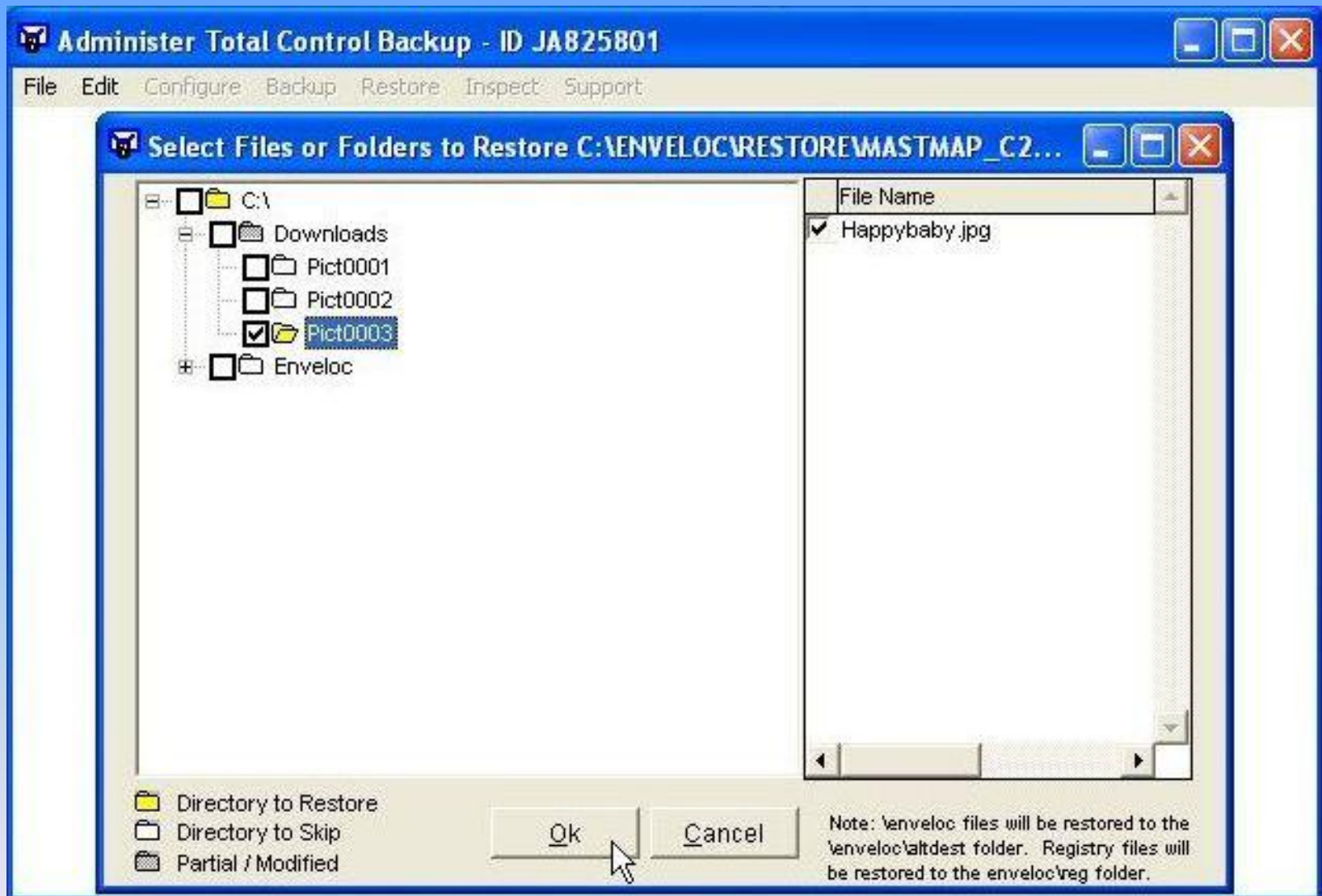
**Click OK to send a request to the server for your directory map**



**Specify the drive letter and date and time to restore to**



**Select the folder(s) or file(s) you want to restore**



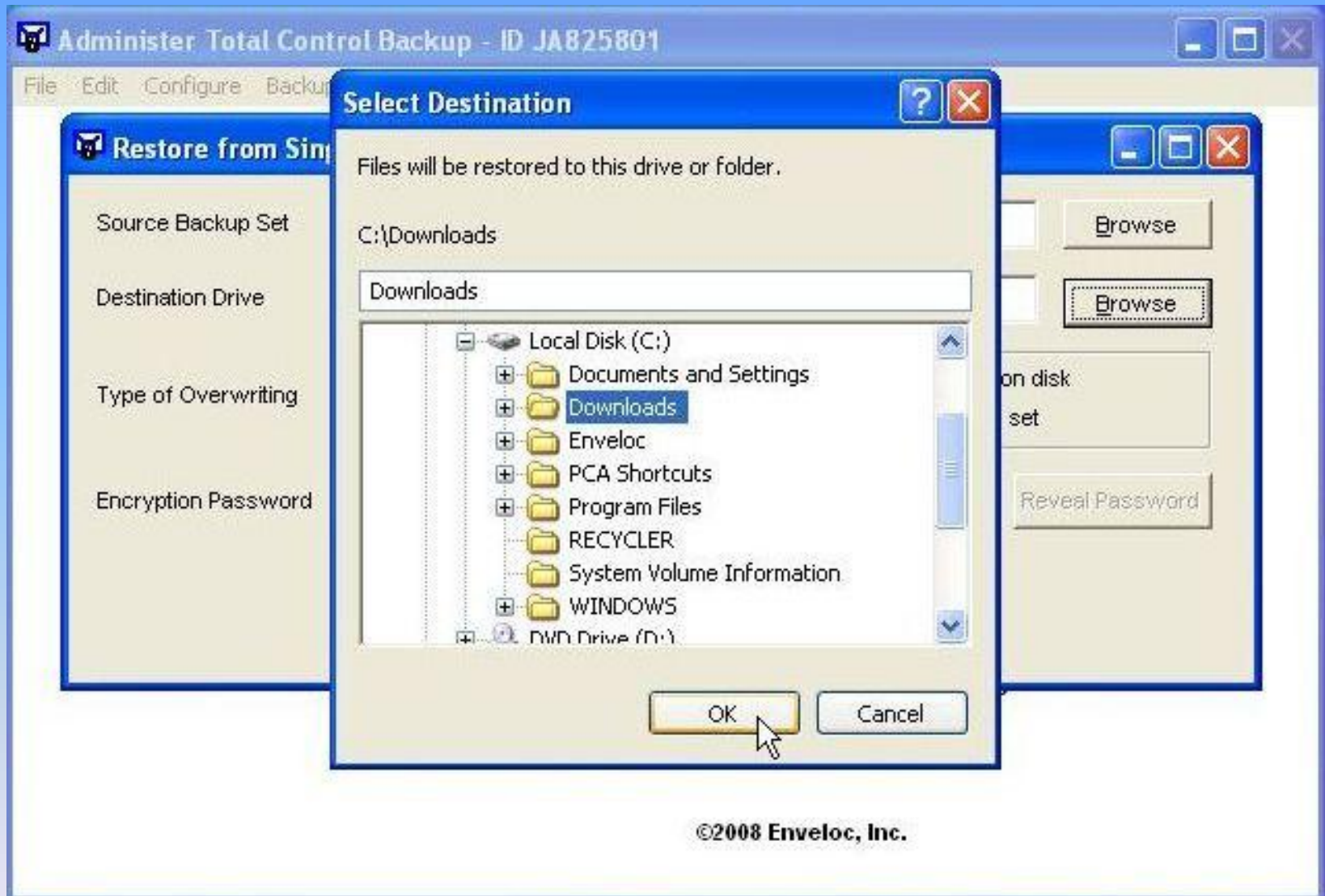
**Click OK and your request is transmitted to the server**

Depending on the size and number of files requested, your wait will vary



When it has downloaded all the files necessary, click OK

**Browse to the desired restoration destination.**



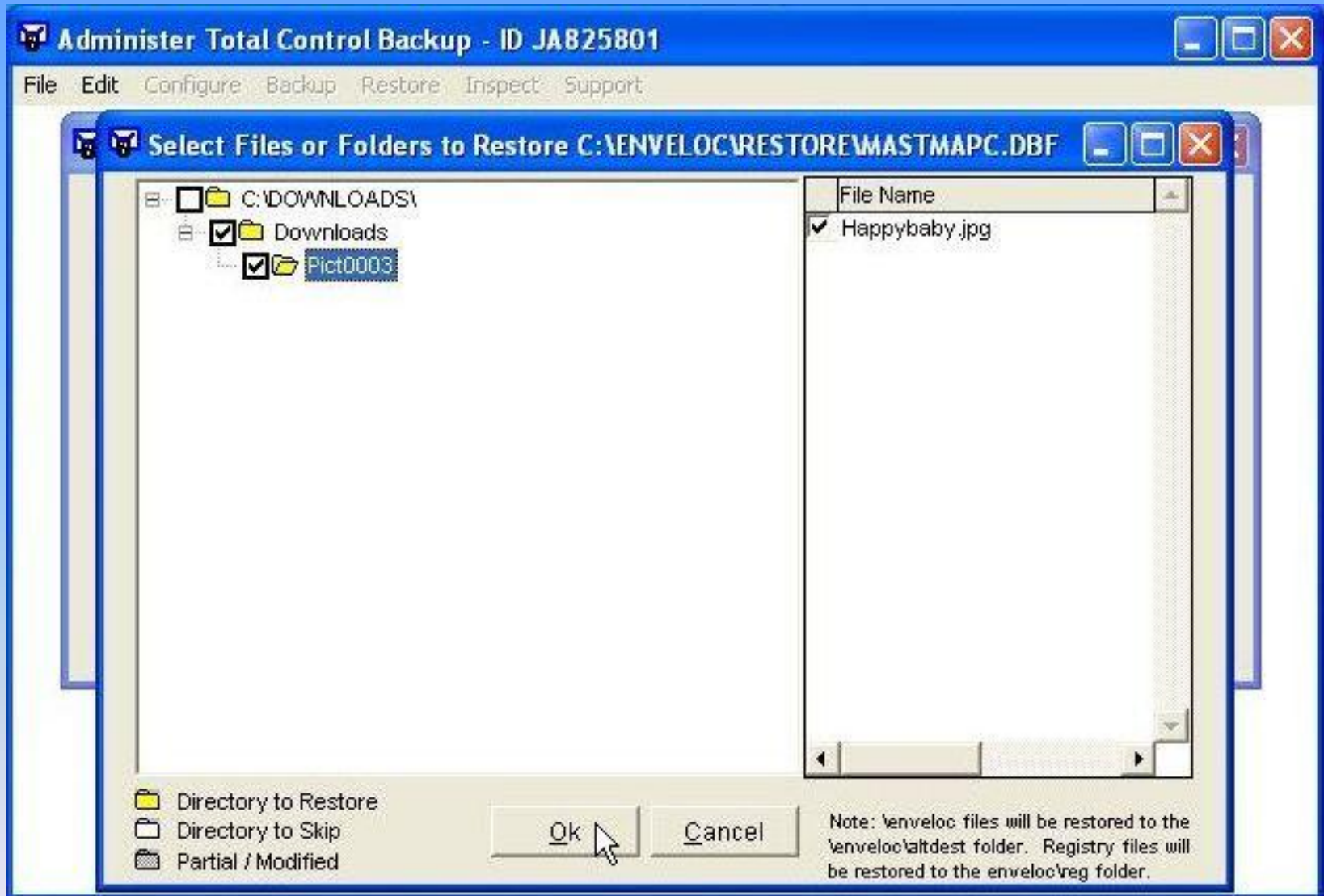
**To restore to the original location choose the root drive (C:\)**

The encryption field will already be filled in if you checked it during setup



If it is not there, enter it carefully. Remember, it is case-sensitive

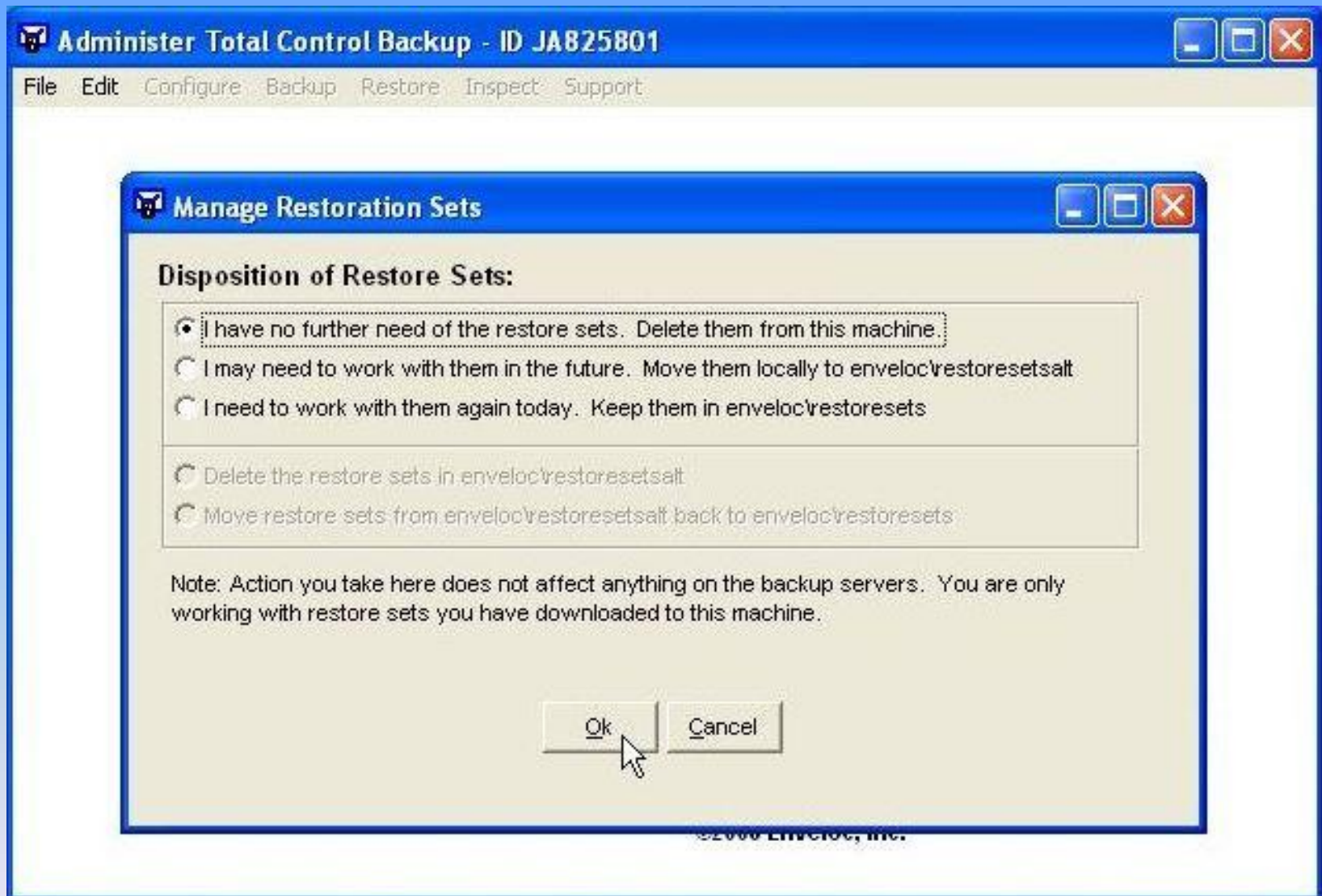
You may choose to fine-tune the list of files to restore.



Uncheck any folders you do not need to restore at this time and click OK



**If there were no exceptions, there is no need to view the log**



**Dispose of the downloaded files or keep them for a later restoration**

## Confirm to delete the downloaded restore sets



**The files being deleted are not the files you just restored, just the backups!**
